Reimagining Policymaking as a Community-Wide Cultural Practice

with **Michael Draskovic** of the *Democracy Policy Network*

Public policy plays a significant role in shaping the contours of our lives, yet it's often the exclusive domain of politicians and special interest groups. What if policymaking was a collaborative process that engaged all members of a community? This presentation will explore strategies for making policymaking a more participatory, inspired, and community-oriented practice.

"Steward-ownership" is an alternative corporate ownership structure that ensures companies prioritize long-term purpose over short-term profits.

It does so by legally enshrining 2 principles: self-determination (power is not held by absentee owners, but by people directly connected to the company's operation and mission) and purpose orientation (profits are means to a purpose, not a goal in itself. Value created in the company cannot be extracted by the shareholders. Profits are reinvested, used to cover capital costs or donated).
